Julie has traveled around the world making music. She believes music to be the international language of the heart. She has toured in Europe, performed in Australia, Japan, the U.S. and the Caribbean.

She is a passionate and experienced composer and songwriter. Her lists of credits include "Stolen Lives: Children In the Sex Trade" which earned her a Leo award for Best Musical Score. Julie received a grant to write and compose the multimedia family musical "Jolly's Journey" and she directed the Children's Chorus on John Denver's final album.

She is a world class pianist and vocalist with extensive training. She has her own recording studio in North Vancouver and has composed for over 50 film and television shows.

Julie is a recording artist with three beautiful instrumental CDs selling internationally, a world beat CD called "If You Dare" and a CD of inspiring songs "Wing & A Prayer". She is currently in production on her new CD in collaboration with Joseph "Pepe" Danza (Westcoast Musician of the Year, Juno nominee);

Julie is the founder of Singspiration Creative Empowerment Training and currently writes for and directs a 60 voice gospel choir who perform professionally twice per year to sold out audiences.

She performs in concert either solo or with her choir and offers musical keynotes at conferences (Noetic Science, Religious Science International, Leading Spas of Canada, Women In Power - open for Marianne Williams).

She regularly facilitates her "*Empower your Voice*" and "*Circle of Song*" workshops in which participants experience confidence breakthroughs, connect with Spirit and with their own inner voice, and experience community through song.

She tours for best selling author Harv Eker in his empowering 'Warrior Camp' and has recently produced an original CD for this event. She has two of her songs coming out on the 2nd Humanity's Team Compilation CD

Julie is a woman who lives what she teaches and sings about. Her warmth and humor combined with a deep sense of purpose make her a dynamic performer and a passionate composer. Julie is the preferred performer at many large, west coast events, (Goldie Hawn's 2005 Fundraising Gala, Matthew Fox's Earth Revival Cosmic Mass event).
